This vacuum cleaner is fitted with a thermal protection device. If the vacuum cleaner stops working, remove the plug from the wall before investigating where the fault lies.

If the vacuum cleaner has a blockage, switch off, remove the plug from the power socket, inspect the floor tool, tubes and hose for debris. If the floor tool, tubes and hose are clear, replace the dust bag and clean the filter.

The vacuum cleaner should be inspected after use for damage.

Make sure you use the appropriate floor tool for the surfaces to be cleaned (Carpet / Hard Floor).

- Regularly examine the power cord. If damage is found such as cracking or ageing the power cord must be replaced by a qualified person.
- Only replace the power cord with the correct Numatic approved replacement part.

- Use to suck up hot ashes or lighted cigarette ends.
- Use steam cleaners or pressure washers to clean the machine or use in the rain.
- Immerse in water for cleaning.
