Numatic International recognises that we cannot continue to produce top-class cleaning equipment without addressing the environmental impact of its products and its operations, we therefore pledge that Numatic International will be:

We will embark on a programme of work to address all aspects of our product's lifecycles and plan for reduction of emissions and later offsetting where required.

In particular we will also;

- 1. Comply with all relevant environmental legislation and with other requirements to which we may subscribe.
- 2. Assess all areas of our operations with respect to our impact on the environment and incorporate those practicable procedures and controls necessary to protect the environment and prevent pollution. Areas of operation include our interactions with external stakeholders such as customers, suppliers and neighbours.
- 3. Continue to achieve our Climate Change Agreement targets and reduce our energy use through investment in newer and more efficient technologies and the coaching of better housekeeping practices. We will also seek to implement savings opportunities highlighted as a consequence of ESOS audits.
- 4. Set and review annual objectives and key performance indicators designed to ensure continual improvement in our environmental performance.
- 5. Improve our emissions data by developing measuring protocols for our products, our supply chain and internal support services.
- 6. Strive to manufacture and sell products that reduce environmental impact but still maintain high levels of performance. This will include reduced energy consumption and the use of recycled or recovered materials in our product construction. We will introduce more practical methods of power free cleaning techniques, improving cleanliness whilst saving even more in energy terms.
- 7. Always design products to be durable, long lasting and to be easily repairable. We will continue our 10 year spare parts availability policy. We will design products to allow for easy recycling at end of life.
- 8. Ensure that all staff are kept aware of this policy, and their individual environmental responsibilities through an appropriate programme of training and awareness enhancement. Display this policy in its offices and all company notice boards. It is available to the general public on application.
- 9. Review this Policy annually.

In order to achieve these objectives, it is the policy of Numatic International Ltd to maintain an effective environmental management system based on the requirements of BS EN ISO 14001.
